

Background

The City of Carmel-by-the-Sea, Building Safety Division is responsible for enforcing the State Building Standards Code (CCR Title 24 and referenced standards therein), as amended by the City under Title 15 of the Carmel Municipal Code (CMC). All submittals for building, plumbing, electrical, mechanical or fire protection systems must demonstrate general conformance with the current edition of CCR Title 24 and CMC Title 15 prior to approval. This SOG is intended to expedite plan review and provide guidance on submitting code conforming plans.

Guidance

Citations on Plans

The plan review services provided by the City of Carmel-by-the-Sea are intended to assure that the plans and other construction documents submitted in an application for a construction permit from the City are in general conformance with the CA Code of Regulations Title 24 (CA Building Standards Code -CBSC) as adopted by under Title 15 of the Carmel Municipal Code. It is the applicant's responsibility to assure that all plans and construction documents demonstrate such compliance prior to submittal. Plans are often submitted that contain notes citing various code sections by reference in-lieu of providing explicit code language on the plans or detailing related drawings and/or specifications in the construction documents. Frequently, such plans are submitted on which the designer has failed to update code citations to reflect the current edition of the CBSC. Inaccurate citations are an inconvenience to both review staff and contractors who depend on the referenced code sections for direction on construction requirements. Inaccurate citations including outdated section call-outs and out of date code references will therefore be sent back to the applicant for correction with no further review, extending the review and approval time for the permit.

2019 Code Compliance

Beginning January 1, 2020, the 2019 ed. of the CA Building Standards Code (CBSC) goes into effect statewide. As of January 1, all plans shall demonstrate through illustration or code citation the requirements of the 2019 CBSC. Failure to provide accurate code references and citations shall be cause for the plans to be rejected as incomplete. *The building official reserves the right to require that designers provide detailed illustrations and complete code language in any plans submitted bearing out-of-date code citations or references.*

Code Access

Many times, plan review and inspection staff are told by both designers and contractors that they do not

own code books and do not reference them while performing their work. Providing accurate code citations on plans does little good when the contractor does not have access to the referenced code sections. The State has recognized this issue and has provided free, on-line access to the adopted CA Building Standards Code including.
