II. **PUBLIC COMMENT**

III. **OLD BUSINESS** *(these are items previously discussed requiring follow-up)*

- A. From the April 28, 2016 meeting- Lincoln & 9th- Two existing disabled parking spaces. Request is for two additional spaces since they are in front of the Senior Center.

IV. **DISCUSSION ITEMS**

- A. Junipero & 4th- request for a disabled stall painted on NW Corner to accommodate residents in apartment complex needing parking or pick-up/ drop-off.
- B. Junipero & 4th- Request to review loading zone near public works entrance and determine if it could be converted into a parking space.
- C. SW Carmelo & 11th- Resident requesting a review of area for designation of No Parking zone by connecting No Parking area on SW corner of San Antonio & 11th.
- D. Residents along Carpenter requesting calming measures to slow traffic traveling north and south on Carpenter between 2nd and 5th Avenue.

- E. Camino Del Monte SW of Junipero- residents concerned about speed of vehicles traveling on Camino Del Monte. Request for additional Speed limit sign posted southwest of the Stop sign at Camino Del Monte.
- F. E/Mission 3 N/4th - Business requesting changing a 2-hour parking stall to a 30-minute zone. Many customers for business don't require 2-hours.
- G. San Carlos & 1st- Resident concerned about speeding vehicles and uncontrolled intersection. Requesting Stop Signs to control vehicles entering intersection. Currently intersection controlled by a yield sign.
- H. NE San Carlos & 8th- vehicles exiting underground parking garage are blocked to oncoming traffic by large vehicles parked in stalls adjacent to entrance to garage. Request for NO truck/ RV parking in two spaces to allow visible view of oncoming vehicles.
- I. Mountain View & Santa Fe- resident requests review of parking along street where roadway becomes too narrow for multiple vehicle to traverse.
- J. Mission & 4th- request made for Resident Only Parking on Mission between 4th & 5th for residents living in apartments.
- K. W/ Dolores 3S 8th- Review roadway in front of residence. Currently one parking space and to the north 3 X's. Provide direction on resolving problem of cars parking in area not X'd and not a parking space.
- L. Torres & 5th- Resident requesting we look at parking area and address how vehicles are parking and make recommendations if any for improvement.
