A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
CARMEL-BY-THE-SEA CERTIFYING THE RESULTS OF  
THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON APRIL 13, 2010

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election was held in the City of Carmel-by-the-Sea, County of Monterey, State of California, in accordance with the laws of the State, on Tuesday, the 13th day of April 2010, to vote on the following as shown in Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the returns from the two consolidated voting precincts, duly established for the holding of said election, have been canvassed pursuant to Section 15301 of the Elections Code, and said canvass certified to the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARMEL-BY-THE-SEA DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the City Clerk is hereby ordered to enter upon the records of this City a statement of the results of said General Municipal Election, which results are hereby declared to be set forth in Exhibit "B", attached hereto, to wit:

SUSAN A. McCLOUD, duly qualified and having received the highest number of votes cast for Mayor, and JASON BURNETT and PAULA HAZDOVAC, duly qualified and having received the highest number of votes cast at said election for Council Members, hereby each declared elected Mayor and Council Member, respectively, of this City for the following terms:

Susan A. McCloud	Two-year Term
Jason Burnett	Four-year Term
Paula Hazdovac	Four-year Term

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
CARMEL-BY-THE-SEA CALLING THE APRIL 13, 2010  
GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF FILLING  
TWO SEATS ON THE CITY COUNCIL AND THE MAYOR'S SEAT AND  
AUTHORIZE THE CITY TO REQUEST THE MONTEREY COUNTY  
ELECTIONS DEPARTMENT TO RELEASE VOTER RECORDS**

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WHEREAS, pursuant to §12000, et seq., Elections Code, the City Council of the City of Carmel-by-the-Sea hereby calls an election to be held on April 13, 2010 for the purpose of electing successors to the terms of office which expire in April 2010; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARMEL-BY-THE-SEA DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

- A. An election will be held within this City on April 13, 2010 for the purpose of filling two seats on the City Council, each for terms of four (4) years, and the Mayor's seat for a term of two (2) years.
- B. That pursuant to the provisions of §10002 of the Elections Code of the State of California, this City Council requests the Board of Supervisors of the County of Monterey to permit the County Election Department to prepare and furnish the following for use in conducting the election:
  - 1.) The computer record of the names and addresses of all eligible registered voters in the City in order that the City's consultant may produce labels for vote-by-mail voters; produce labels for sample ballot pamphlets; and print rosters of voters and street indexes.
  - 2.) Voter signature verification services, as needed.
  - 3.) Make available to the City election equipment and assistance according to State law.
- C. Martin & Chapman, Co., as the elections consultant to the City, shall conduct the official canvass and report the results of said canvass to the City Council on the Tuesday following the election.
- D. The City Council of the City of Carmel-by-the-Sea shall meet on the first Tuesday following the election, April 20, 2010, and install the newly-elected Council Members and Mayor (§10262 et seq., Elections Code).
- E. The City Council authorizes the City Clerk to administer said election and all reasonable and actual election expenses shall be paid by the City upon presentation of a properly submitted bill.




