  - \$25 jury fee (jury fees are NON-RFUNDABLE and must be paid in cash or check. Please make checks payable to the City of Carmel-by-the-Sea)
  - o A copy of your valid California Seller's Permit if you have one
  - Examples of your work to be evaluated by the Selection Committee (approximately 5-10 samples)
  - You are required to bring photographs of your work to leave with the judges (photos will not be returned)
  - o A drawing of your proposed booth display setup
- All applicants/vendors *must* appear in person and represent their own original work
  - Vendors may display and sell only the type of work which was juried

The Selection Committee will be selecting the most original and well-made crafts to be sold at the Homecrafters' Marketplace

- You will be notified by email if you are selected for the 2019 Homecrafters' Marketplace:
  - \* If Selected:
    - o The fee for a 10 x 10 booth space is \$205.
