	GENERAL:	
	Did this project previously go out to bid in August, 2023?	This project went out to bid as part of a larger multi-trade project in August, 2023. That project did not get awarded. This bid package differs from the previous package in that the scope of work is now painting only.
	SUNSET CENTER:	
1	Is there any "Sanding" required?	Sanding is not allowed. See Section 020800, 3.3, 2.h.
2	How many Paint Layers are asked for?	Two to three layers, depending on the material being painted. See Section 099000, Item C.
3	Are the railings and window bars/grilles included in the scope?	All handrail and window bar systems directly attached to the building are included in the scope of work. Any handrails not attached to the building are excluded.
4	How will the debris from power washing be mitigated?	See Section 020800 ABATEMENT, specifically Asbestos Abatement and Lead Containing Paint Removal, for instructions.
5	Are the windows currently operable?	The majority of windows are operational. Operational windows are to remain operational. Non-operable windows may remain non-operable.
6	How will non-operational windows be noted?	Contractor to verify any non-operational windows with City staff at start of project.

7	Can you please provide plans of Sunset Center which show the locations of the windows with Asbestos Window Putty and the windows without Asbestos Window putty? The building is a 2 story and it's important to know the exact locations of the windows with Asbestos Window Putty.	Assume all window putty contains asbestos.
8	Do we only need to complete the following work "WINDOW PUTTY: REMOVE LOOSE, CRUMBLY OR FLAKY, APPLY NEW WHERE MISSING, THEN PRIME AND PAINT." per HazMat General Note 6., plan sheets A3.0 to A3.2 or we need to remove all loose, crumbly or flaky window putty regardless of HazMat material?	Contractor is to remove all loose, crumbly or flaky window putty regardless of HazMat material.

1	What were the results of the Lead testing?	See APPENDIX C - HAZMAT REPORTS.
2	What will be done with the bird netting?	See APPENDIX D - PROJECT DRAWINGS, Exterior Elevation General Notes, Item 2.
3	Are ceiling tiles on the 2 nd floor to be painted?	See APPENDIX D - PROJECT DRAWINGS, Interior Finish Schedule on Sheet A2.0
4	What are the working job hours?	8 am to 5 pm, Monday through Friday
5	Will the interior murals in basement level be painted over?	Yes.
6	Will the color be "like for like" or is there a new scheme?	See APPENDIX D - PROJECT DRAWINGS, Interior Finish Schedule and sheets A3.0 and A3.1 for Exterior painting colors.
7	What is to be done with the Bathroom Wallpaper?	See APPENDIX D - PROJECT DRAWINGS, Interior Finish Schedule on Sheet A2.1
8	Does the ceiling in the "Kitchen" (bottom floor) get fixed?	Loose ceiling tiles must be reattached or replaced in kind, then painted, by contractor.
9	Is the City providing the abatement service, or is the contractor required to do that?	Contractor is to provide asbestos abatement and lead paint removal. The City will contract separately with the observation/monitoring service.
