**Project Description:** 1) The expansion of the property's south side yard wood deck by 23 square feet to total 123 square feet. 2) The installation of a new 4' high, 10' wide driveway gate and pedestrian gate composed of cedar board and batten panels and steel posts with a paint finish. 3) The installation of new grape stake palings attached to the top of a 30' section of the existing 4'-6" south side yard fence, raising the height to 6' maximum. 4) Shifting the existing south side yard trash enclosure back to the west as conditioned by the Special Conditions of this approval since it is located in the 3-foot side-yard setback. 5) A new 231 square-foot pea gravel patio in the rear yard of the property. 6) Installation of a new 3' x 4' gas fire pit in the new gravel patio in the rear yard. 7) New sand-set stepping stones to the north of the driveway from the wood deck to the pea gravel patio. 8) Installation of 5 new wall-mounted, shielded, down-facing lights with a maximum lumen output of 269 lumens. 9) Installation of 5 new landscape lights that will be shielded, down-facing and limited to 33 lumens each. 10) New landscaping as approved by the Carmel Forestry Department. 11) The proposed ribbon driveway is being processed under Driveway Replacement Permit DV 19-224 (Ward).
