Biographical Description:

Margye Neswitz was born in Brownsboro, Texas to parents Ivy and Mana Fulgham.

Graduating from Baylor University with a Bachelor of Arts in Drama, she met her husband, Philip Neswitz, during a stage performance in Chicago. For over 20 years the couple traveled together before settling down in Pacific Grove, California. Mrs. Neswitz got a job with the now defunct Pacific Grove Tribune. She went to work at the Carmel Pine Cone, and finally in the early 1980's to write a society column for the Monterey County Herald. She hosted a spot on the afternoon news. Neswitz socialized with prominent members of the community, reporting on the happenings at high society parties and events. She

received several awards for her contributions to the local community, including accolades from the American Red Cross and American Cancer Society. Neswitz died of a heart attack on December 26, 2000.
