Attached is a proposed revision to Attachment B, Conditions of Approval, for the Beach Fire Management pilot program. To clarify, user-supplied gas-fueled devices would be allowed year-round south of Tenth Avenue as part of the pilot. The portable wood or charcoal burning devices to be distributed by the City would occur during holiday weekends associated with Memorial Day, July 4th and Labor Day. The pilot proposes 25 of these devices to be available for the first year of the pilot. Thank you for the consideration of this revision.
