A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARMEL-BY-THE-SEA DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE ELECTION HELD ON MARCH 3, 2020 FOR THE SUBMISSION OF AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE 1V, TRANSACTIONS AND USE TAX, OF CHAPTER 3.28, SALES AND USE TAX, OF THE CARMEL-BY-THE-SEA MUNICIPAL CODE TO INCREASE THE TRANSACTIONS AND USE TAXES (SALES TAX) RATE TO ONE AND ONE HALF PERCENT (1.5%) FOR A PERIOD OF TWENTY (20) YEARS FOR GENERAL PURPOSES

WHEREAS, on October 8, 2019 the City Council of the City of Carmel-by-the-Sea adopted Resolution 2019-070 which authorized an election to be consolidated with the Statewide General Election on Tuesday, March 3, 2020 for the purpose of submission of "Measure C": an Ordinance amending Article 1V, Transactions and Use Tax, of Chapter 3.28, Sales and Use Tax, of the Carmel-by-the-Sea Municipal Code to increase the Transactions and Use Taxes (Sales Tax) rate to one and one half percent (1.5%0 for a period of twenty (20) years for general purposes; and

WHEREAS, the election was held on said date as required by law and the Registrar of Voters of the County of Monterey has duly canvassed the votes cast by the electors in the City of Carmel-by-the-Sea and has supplied the City Council the certification of the results of the canvass and the final results of the votes cast which are attached as Exhibit A and declared in all respects; and

WHEREAS, the Monterey County Elections Department canvassed the returns of the election, has provided the results and those results are hereby attached and made a part hereof as Exhibit A.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARMEL-BY-THE-SEA:

The City Clerk is instructed to enter into the records of this City Council this Resolution as a statement of the result of said election.

All absentee and provisional ballots have been duly received and canvassed in the time, form and manner as required by Law.

The whole number of votes cast for Measure C which will increase the Transactions and Use Taxes (Sales Tax) rate to one and one half percent (1.5%) for a period of twenty (20) years for general purposes was 1624;

The number of votes cast for Measure C are as follows:

YES – 983 NO – 641 The number of votes cast at each precinct are as provided in Attachment A

Measure C received a majority of votes cast and therefore is hereby approved.
