Agenda: Brief General Description

Government Code Section 54954.2(a)(1):

"At least 72 hours before a regular meeting, the legislative body of the local agency, or its designee, shall post an agenda containing a brief general description of each item of business to be transacted or discussed at the meeting, including items to be discussed in closed session. A brief general description of an item generally need not exceed 20 words."

Agenda Item title:

Receive a presentation on the exploration of street addresses, to be discussed, and provide direction



Staff Report Recommendation

Recommendation (from the July 9, 2024, Staff Report):

Receive a presentation on the exploration of assigning street addresses in the City of Carmel-by-the-Sea. Consider and provide direction on the Ad Hoc Committee's recommendation to move forward with the assignment of street addresses in the City of Carmel-by-the-Sea and create an implementation plan and return to City Council no later than September 2024.



Motion on July 9, 2024 – Street Addresses

Motion (from July 9th Meeting Minutes):

Motion by Councilmember Ferlito to direct staff to move forward with street address implementation, and return in September with an implementation plan, community engagement plan, and return in September with an Ordinance to amend the municipal code removing the provision allowing directional addresses, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Richards, and approved 3-2-0-0 (Councilmember Dramov and Mayor voted no)

 Second Reading and Adoption of Ordinance
