**Historical Description:**

*The Weekly Sun* was a local newspaper published in Carmel from 1991-1993.

**Scope and Content:**

This collection consists of alphabetical subject files from the office of the *Weekly Sun*. The files, which contain press releases, promotional materials, photographs, articles, and correspondence, were gathered by reporters and used to write newspaper articles. The collection includes materials (meeting agendas, correspondence, memoranda, reports, maps, diagrams) concerning major land development proposals that were of concern to the local community during the early 1990s. There is extensive material concerning the controversial, and ultimately unsuccessful, proposal to build the Hatton Canyon Freeway through Carmel. The collection also documents the successful re-development of the Mission Ranch after its purchase by Clint Eastwood, and the unsuccessful

attempt to build a housing development (“Coast Ranch”) on the Odello family property off of Highway 1, just south of Carmel. The collection also includes two EIRs pertaining to the Coast Ranch development which are housed with the printed materials (call numbers 609 and 609B).
