## DESIGN STUDY/LANDSCAPE PLAN APPROVAL LD 23-247 (Gonzales)

## AUTHORIZATION:

Approval of this Design Study/Landscape Plan authorizes the installation of new landscaping in the City right-of-way outside of the property located at Dolores 3 SE 3rd. All landscaping shall be installed in accordance with the approved landscape plan dated approved on September 13, 2023 on file in the Community Planning & Building Department unless modified by the conditions of approval herein.

## **STANDARD CONDITIONS:**

- ☑ Notice of Authorized Work. A building permit is not required for landscape installation; however, the applicant shall obtain a Notice of Authorized work form after the 10-day posting period. The Notice of Authorized Work shall be obtained by uploading a <u>complete</u> "Scope of Work Declaration" with a signed copy of these Conditions of Approval to the City's <u>Online Permit Portal</u>. There shall be no fee for the review or issuance of the Notice of Authorized Work.
- ☑ Signed and Printed Conditions. A signed copy of these Conditions of Approval shall be returned to the Community Planning and Building Department prior to the issuance of a Notice of Authorized Work. See condition above (Notice of Authorized Work).
- Decomposed Granite Pathway. The Decomposed Granite Pathway shall not exceed 3' in width at any point within the public right-of-way. The pathway shall run perpendicular from the property line to the street edge.
- ☑ Modifications. The applicant shall submit in writing, with revised plans, to the Community Planning and Building staff any proposed changes to the approved project plans prior to incorporating those changes. If the applicant changes the project without first obtaining City approval, the applicant will be required to submit the change in writing, with revised plans, within 2 weeks of the City being notified. A cease work order may be issued any time at the discretion of the Director of Community Planning and Building until: a) either the Planning Commission or Staff has approved the change, or b) the property owner has eliminated the change and submitted the proposed change in writing, with revised plans, for review. The project will be reviewed for its compliance to the approved plans prior to final inspection.
- ☑ Final Inspection. The applicant shall contact the City Forester for a final inspection upon completion of the installation of the landscaping to review consistency with the approved landscape plan. (831)620-2073.
- ☑ 811 Ticket Number. Prior to issuance of the Notice of Authorized Work form, the applicant shall contact the appropriate regional notification center (USA North 811) at least two working days, but not more than 14 calendar days, prior to commencing that excavation or digging. No digging or excavation is authorized to occur on site until the applicant has obtained a Ticket Number and all utility members have positively

responded to the dig request. (Visit USANorth811.org for more information)

- ☑ Clearance From Trees. During construction, no dirt or construction materials or equipment may be placed within 6 feet of the base of any tree.
- ✓ Tree Roots. If any tree roots larger than two inches (2") are encountered during construction, the City Forester shall be contacted before cutting the roots. The City Forester may be reached at (831) 620-2073.
- ☑ Indemnification Statement. The applicant agrees, at the applicant's sole expense, to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the City, its public officials, officers, employees, and assigns, from any liability; and shall reimburse the City for any expense incurred, resulting from, or in connection with any project approvals. This includes any appeal, claim, suit, or other legal proceeding, to attack, set aside, void, or annul any project approval. The City shall promptly notify the applicant of any legal proceeding, and shall cooperate fully in the defense. The City may, at its sole discretion, participate in any such legal action, but participation shall not relieve the applicant of any obligation under this condition. Should any party bring any legal action in connection with this project, the Superior Court of the County of Monterey, California, shall be the situs and have jurisdiction for the resolution of all such actions by the parties hereto.
